# Audio + Video Requirements

Ankur likes to do an A/V test fashionably close to his presentation— 30-60 minutes before showtime!

## **COMPUTER AND PROJECTION**

To ensure a flawless and visually stunning presentation, Ankur takes matters into his own hands. No event slide templates for him, except for the obligatory title and end title slides, if you insist. Ankur relies on his trusty M3 MacBook Pro with a USB-C input to run his PowerPoint presentation. Connecting to your projection system is a breeze with an HDMI dongle or a USB-C dongle. As a precaution, Ankur sends his PowerPoint presentation to the client at least 48 hours in advance, in case it needs to be uploaded on their home computer system. And as a backup, he always has the presentation ready on a cloud link to download again if needed. Oh, and did I mention? Ankur's PowerPoint is in the sleek 16:9 display ratio. Now, all the client needs to provide is a computer system, a large screen or projector, a professional audio setup, and a wireless slide clicker.

#### **VIDEO, SOUND, MICROPHONE**

Ankur's talks normally contain embedded videos and sounds. Please double check with Ankur to ensure that the audio levels are set for the presentation and that the videos don't lag.

Ankur needs a wireless lavalier mic. If no wireless mic is around, kindly pass the "mic drop" moment with a hand-held mic.

## **CONFIDENCE MONITOR AND TIMER**

Ankur likes to have a confidence monitor on stage, facing the speaker. It shows the current and next slide on two different monitors, along with a timer showing the remaining presentation time. And if two monitors aren't available, just one confidence monitor with the current slide facing the speaker will do the trick.

### **NOTHING ON STAGE**

Ankur likes his stage as obstacle-free as possible, allowing him to roam freely during his presentation. If a podium is unavoidable, kindly stage left or stage right, granting him the freedom to strut his stuff!
